



## **Fresh Air and Colorful Autumn Scenery Await in Cooperstown, New York Plan an Invigorating Fall Getaway at The Otesaga Resort Hotel with New Seasonal Packages**

Cooperstown, New York (August 18, 2020) – Although this year’s forecast has been continuously bleak on a variety of levels, our world continues to turn, seasons continue to change, and before we know it, the first eye-popping colors of fall will make their welcome appearance. In south central New York state lies the charming lakeside haven of Cooperstown, affectionally nicknamed “America’s Most Perfect Village.” If you’re feeling up to a road-trip getaway so you can enjoy the outdoors and breathe in the crisp autumn air, Cooperstown is a convenient and scenic drive from several northeast cities including Baltimore, Boston, New York and Philadelphia.

The village is a celebrated hotspot for catching gorgeous views of multicolored leaves, and fall foliage typically peaks here between mid-September to mid-October. This fall, visitors can take advantage of two new seasonal packages from the iconic [Otesaga Resort Hotel](#) that overlooks Lake Otsego and is just steps from downtown Cooperstown’s Main Street.

Guests can book the **“Autumn On The Lake Special,”** available September 1 through October 10, and enjoy value rates from \$199 per room, per night. For stays between October 11 through November 24, guests can enjoy rates as low as \$179 per room, per night. This special includes charming and spacious accommodations, a hearty breakfast each day, bottle of signature Otesaga wine, complimentary Wi-Fi and free parking.

The Otesaga partnered with Cooperstown’s renowned [Fenimore Art Museum](#) to offer the **“Fall For Fenimore Package,”** also available this autumn. Guests who book this special will enjoy rates from \$219 per room, per night starting September 5 through October 10, and from \$199 per room, per night from October 11 through November 24 (both rates are based on double occupancy). This special includes overnight accommodations, breakfast each day, complimentary Wi-Fi and parking, and admission to Fenimore Art Museum, where visitors can see this season’s exciting exhibits including *Pete Souza: Two Presidents, One Photographer* and *Albrecht Dürer: MasterPrints*.

The resort's pool, spa and recreational activities are currently closed, but there's still plenty of fall fun to be found along the shores of Otsego Lake. Get cozy and admire the vivid fall colors while sipping cocktails on the resort's veranda, which overlooks Otsego Lake, or tee off at one of the top golf courses in New York at the resort's award-winning [Leatherstocking Golf Course](#). The world-renowned [National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum](#) is open to visitors, and so is the interactive [Farmers' Museum](#), which recreates what life was like on a farm in the early 19<sup>th</sup> century.

The Otesaga has welcomed guests back to Cooperstown with a collection of improved safety and hygiene protocols in place. The resort implemented [Otesaga CARE](#), a program that exceeds the sanitation standards recommended by state and federal agencies to provide a **Clean And Responsible Environment** for all. Currently, the resort has resumed modified operations of its restaurants, all in accordance with guidance from federal, state and local health authorities. Many sights, flavors and activities of fall can be enjoyed in the region. Just outside of Cooperstown is the popular [Middlefield Orchard](#), where you can pick your own apples and pumpkins through the end of October. Safety and social distancing measures are in place so visitors can enjoy nature. The kids will especially love the rows of dwarf trees that make it easy for them to find and pick their own apples. Also nearby is the historic, water-powered [Fly Creek Cider Mill](#) that's been pressing fresh, sweet cider for 163 years. The Mill Store Marketplace is open (with safety precautions in place), offering more than 40 specialty foods including fresh fudge, mill-aged cheeses, ciders, wines and much more.
