



Plan a Sports-Themed Getaway to The Otesaga Resort Hotel

Cooperstown, New York (March 24, 2026) – Fans eager for the return of baseball on March 25 and 26 can enjoy an extra dose of America’s pastime with a trip to Cooperstown, New York. The upstate village is home to the [National Baseball Hall of Fame and Museum](#), historic [Doubleday Field](#), and numerous shops and restaurants that pay tribute to the all-American sport. Choose a stay at the official hotel partner of the Hall of Fame, [The Otesaga Resort Hotel](#), which offers additional sports-focused activities beyond baseball for guests to enjoy during the warmer months.

- The Otesaga is home to one of the East Coast’s top public golf courses, [Leatherstocking Golf Course](#). The challenging, par-72, 18-hole championship course tests golfers’ skills with diverse elevations and a unique layout along the lake.
- Trade golf clubs for a racket or paddle to play on the resort’s **tennis and pickleball courts** when weather permits. All equipment is available at the resort’s concierge desk.

- The 132-room historic resort is situated along the calming shores of Otsego Lake, offering a variety of **water activities** from late May through September. Pick from **kayaks, canoes or rowboats** to explore the lake, or participate in **fishing lessons** at the hotel's private dock.
- For those seeking to practice their breaststroke, take a dip in The Otesaga's heated **outdoor pool**, which opens on Memorial Day weekend.
- Participate in one of the resort's **yoga sessions** to reset the mind and body. These are offered by the lake on Wednesdays through Sundays.
- Join a guided group **bike ride** on Wednesday afternoons or set out independently on a bike rented from the resort.
- The Otesaga provides a **5K running map** so guests can embark at their own pace. There's also a **guided stroll** through the village of Cooperstown on Tuesday mornings.

Getting back to baseball, which is the draw for so many visitors to Cooperstown, The Otesaga celebrates the sport with displays of wine glasses for all living Hall of Famers, who visit the hotel during the Hall of Fame's Induction Weekend in late July. There are also menu items tied to the sport, like the Abner Doubleday dessert cocktail – featuring hot coffee, rum, Kahlua and whipped cream – at its signature restaurant, [1909](#), and top-rated burgers at [Hawkeye Bar & Grill](#).

The Otesaga offers baseball-themed packages, such as its [Double Play Package](#), which includes accommodations, tickets to the Hall of Fame and a souvenir mini baseball bat with a logo. And for stays between April 1 through May 26, the resort is offering a special \$250 rate through its [Celebrate 250 Special](#) that includes a commemorative gift.
