though the resort's award-winning Leatherstocking Golf Course is closed for the season, guests can still practice their swing by booking a game on the Trackman indoor golf simulator at the Otesaga's Clubhouse. Plus, Hawkeye Spa offers additional opportunities for wintertime relaxation and pampering with massages, facials and add-on enhancements.

Guests staying at the 132-room resort can enjoy meals at its signature restaurant, Hawkeye Bar & Grill, which serves locally sourced ingredients for breakfast, lunch and dinner. On Wednesdays and Thursdays, the restaurant also offers a three-course internationally themed dinner that highlights a different culture each week.
