Known as “America’s Sports Car,” the Corvette has continuously evolved alongside American innovation, from early performance models to today’s cutting-edge designs. That evolution now includes the Corvette E-Ray, which blends electric tech with the

unmistakable power and style that turned the Corvette into such an icon, and the all-new ZRX1, which is Corvette's most advanced model yet. Visitors can explore this evolution firsthand at the [National Corvette Museum](#) and at [NCM Motorsports Park](#) with a lap around their track in an E-Ray. The museum's new collections facility, set to open to the public later this year or early in 2027, will offer an expanded look at the history of America's Sports Car.

At the [Kentucky Museum](#), the new "Sonic Landscape" exhibit explores the changing musical identity of Southcentral Kentucky, capturing how sound has shifted across generations. From traditional influences to modern interpretations, the exhibit highlights the way music reflects culture, place and progress. Similar to the resurgence of record players in our digital age, it shows how the old and new don't need to compete, but instead can coexist, creating something more meaningful.

The same remix plays out in the city's historic downtown, where classic Main Street architecture sets the stage for modern, trend-forward shopping and dining experiences. New businesses are adding fresh energy to familiar streets, including [Thirsty's Drink Stop](#), which puts a contemporary spin on soda fountain nostalgia through the popular dirty soda trend; [Vette City Vintage](#), which brings thrifting and retro items to the downtown area; and [Amothecary](#), offering one-of-a-kind finds with its collection of curios.
